

Maritime Trainee includes five academic modules in Norway, Singapore and London. The academic program comprises three areas that are represented in all modules:

1. MARITIME KNOWLEDGE

A central aim of the program is to ensure that you gain a comprehensive understanding of the maritime industry. Initially, there is a general introduction to the industry and different market applications where maritime services are needed. This includes focus on markets such as offshore oil and gas, offshore wind, offshore marine and services related to transport of goods and passengers.

2. MANAGEMENT COMPETENCE
